NOVEMBER 1

- 1. Submit your AAPI on the <u>APPIC website</u> for **each** site that you're interested in, as applications are reviewed separately by each internship site.
- Be sure to include: 2.
 - A copy of your vitae Graduate transcripts

 - 3 letters of reference
 - Any additional site-specific requirements noted in the site brochure (such as a work sample)



STEP 2: USAJOBS

MID – NOVEMBER

- Upon AAPI review, the sites that would like to interview you will send you an email with an invitation and instructions to apply on USAJobs. This additional step is a requirement of the federal government and is intended to certify your eligibility for federal employment.
- Complete the USAJobs application and submit all required 2. documentation, including:
 - Resume
 - Transcript verifying current enrollment in a doctoral program
 - AAPI verification
- Read the USAJobs posting carefully to ensure you are completing the 3. application correctly and providing all of the required information.
- After submission and review, qualified applicants will be notified of 4.

<u>STEP 3: LET'S MEET!</u>

- 1. Applicable site Internship Program Coordinators will contact you to begin scheduling your interview.
- 2. Interviews consist of:
 - Passing a security clearance procedure:
 - Core Values Assessment
 - Integrity interview
 - Panel interview (you will be asked to respond to correctional scenarios)
 - Psychology interview(s)



Note: The results of the security clearance procedure can be shared across sites, and you will only need to complete this process once. Please refer to the site brochures for site-specific interview information.
